Who benefits from food banks?

In British Columbia, more than 100,000 people turn to local food banks each year in order to acquire the sustenance they need. Over half of all households that rely on food banks are families with children; half these again are headed by single parents. In total, almost 40% of recipients of food bank assistance are under the age of 18.

Food banks need our help

Roughly a third of our food banks are reporting that they simply do not have enough food to meet current requirements. The vast majority of them receive no forms of government aid, relying instead on the generosity of private groups and individuals for financial and material support.

Items most needed

- canned meat & fish
- canned fruit/vegetables
- rice, whole wheat pasta
- pasta sauce
- peanut butter
- baby formula, baby food

How Collection Week Works: Some 6000 volunteers will visit BC neighbourhoods in September.

Collection week: Business & Condo Association contributors will contact their local food drive community leader notifying them they have a food box to be delivered/collected.

Collection day: On collection day a volunteer from the Business or Condo Association will deliver the food box to a drop-off location that they will receive from their local food drive community leader.
